Dear Representative or Family Member,

As you are aware, Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center is committed to maintaining the health and safety of our residents. In light of the recent developments regarding the Coronavirus (CO-VID 19) and in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control, we will ask that all visitors to the facility **only utilize the main entrance in to the building.**

**The entrances to Transitions, Heritage Harbor and the Administration entrance will be closed until further notice.**

In addition, the receptionist will be screening visitors upon entry to the facility by asking the following questions prior to obtaining a visitor pass:

- Has there been any International travel within the last 14 days?
- Do you have signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection such as fever, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath?
- Have you had contact with someone with or under investigation for COVID-19?

**Visitor with any yes responses will be highly encouraged to defer visitation until no longer potentially infectious (24 hours after resolution of fever without antipyretic medication).**

We ask for your patience and cooperation as we implement recommended guidance through the following process to keep our residents safe.
